Tuesday, June 29 **Letters from Rifka** by Karen Hesse. A twelve year old girl travels with her family from the Ukraine through Poland to Ellis Island, but she has to be left behind to recover from ringworm. What adventures the family encounters! These are the letters she writes to family in Russia and the United States until she can join them. A heartwarming immigration book!

Wed., July 14 **Eleven** by Patricia Reilly Giff. Sam has always had trouble reading, but he finds a document in his beloved grandfather's musty attic that makes him think he was kidnapped. As he works with his friend, Caroline, on a school project, they try to discover his real past.

Wed., August 11 **Chasing Vermeer** by Blue Balliet. A pair of new friends, Petra and Calder, try to find a missing Vermeer painting in their native Chicago using clues from the newspaper. This won an Edgar Allen Poe Award for mysteries for children. See what you think!
