Sat., November 19 **The BFG** by Roald Dahl. Sophie, an orphan, is kidnapped by a giant! Is he really friendly? Can he give her pleasant dreams? Can he protect her from the other giants who eat small boys and girls?

Sat., January 7 **The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane** by Kate DiCamillo. A dearly loved white china rabbit disappears over the side of a boat, breaking a young girl's heart. The travels of the rabbit help him learn to love and to care for many people he meets along his way. And what happens to him and his new friends? And what do you think?

Sat., March 3 **Loser** by Jerry Spinelli. Zinkoff never wins, but he stays busy. He doesn't always hear the unkind word people call him. Trace his journey from first grade through 6th. And see if you think that in the end, he is a hero!
